Principal's Report

The following updates were presented by the Principal, Jim Horvath and the Vice Principal, Peter Petrucelli:

Youth Edge Ministry has been opened

- The school will be providing support to families within the school through funds raised from dress down day as well as contributions from staff.
- Training is available for all new executive members of the council
- The Chair, Sunny Kanabe emerged as the Alternate Rep of the Brampton East/ Caledon/Dufferin/ Malton family of schools at the CCCSC.
- The school has been busy and the staff continue to be highly involved with students' activities.
- Teachers working with Student and CPTs. Exams will be held this Semester.
- The school admin is making efforts to address the heating problem which has been observed in the school building. The school is on deck for full replacement of heat pump units which will be done in phases.
- There are monthly health and safety inspections to ensure the safety of students and staff.
- Discussions are ongoing on the proposal to modify the school uniforms to include another sweater. The school council will be engaged.
- The Girls Basketball team will be Playing for the championship on November 30, 2022 @ 3:00 p.m.
- Grade 8 Open Night is scheduled for Wednesday, November 30, 2022.
- A New sound system has been installed in the gym. There are new monitors all over the building used to announce events and showcase different feeds.
- Different activities will be hosted for the Christmas season for the students during lunch leading up to the holidays.
- The Media studio has been refurbished with Mac Computers.
- Catholic School Improvement Learning Cycle will focus on: Health & Wellbeing of students; Faith
 Development; Descriptive Feedback (as there are significant gaps in math and learning) The school has
 engaged teachers to meet and develop skills around providing this type of feedback.
